our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred & Seventy Seven Between —
Henry Haoten Son: of the County of Dunmore & Colony of Virginia
of the one part and Peter Haoten of the County and Colony aforesaid
of the other Part WITNESSETH that the said Henry Haoten Son:
for & in consideration of the sum of five Shillings Current money of
Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Peter Haoten at or before the
sealing and Delivery of these Presents (The Receipt whereof is hereby
Acknowledged) hath Granted, Bargained, & sold, & by these Presents doth
Grant, bargain & sell unto the said Peter Haoten a certain Tract or parcel
of Land lying & being in the County of Dunmore on the South side the
South River of Shanandoah, being part of a tract of Land granted from his
Lordships Office to the said Henry Haoten Son: and Bound'd as followeth
Beginning at a Marsh Stake on the river bank corner to Jacob —
Haoten and running down the several courses of the River S^E 72° E⁵⁰'
50 poles, S^E 70° E³⁶ poles then S^E 92° East 23 poles to a forked Ash the lower
corner on the River, then leaving the River and running S^E 12° East 30 poles
to a white oak & Red Oak corner to John Bumgarner then S^E 30° East
200 poles to two pines then N^W 60° East 60 poles to a pine then S^E 60° East
110 poles to a pine then S^E 30° West 73 poles to three pines corner to Jacob
Haoten, then with his line N^W 71° E¹⁹⁰ poles to two white Oaks then
N^W 55° East 92 poles to two White Oaks then N^W 32° West 106 poles to a —
